Equipped with 2 parallel assembly lines, each comprising 4 workstations, the aircraft is built with proven elements and technologies (certified OEMs) from all over the world:

- Rotax engine (Austria),
- Beringer brake system (France),
- Fixed pitch propeller from DUC Hélices (France),
- Garmin Avionics Suite (US)
- ...



The team working on the assembly line is made up of highly qualified junior and senior profiles partly from the various subsidiaries of the Sonaca aerospace group. The assembly site also includes Engineering, Supply Chain, Purchasing, Quality, Production Support, Finance, Sales divisions and an After-Sales Service.

### 3 PLANES PER MONTH.

Sonaca Aircraft's current clients are flight training schools and flying clubs in England, Belgium, Estonia, France, Switzerland and Turkey. To date, 25 Sonaca 200 aircraft are flying in Europe and beyond. There will be 30 by the end of 2020. The first aircraft have reached 1000 hours and the whole fleet is approaching 7500 flying hours.

The delivery time for an aircraft varies between 9 and 12 months.

In the current context, Sonaca Aircraft supports its clients by organizing certain deliveries (ferry flight). A team of professional pilots (who work on behalf of Sonaca Aircraft) is responsible for delivering the aircraft to clients in Europe and beyond.

### In the course of assembly : the Sonaca 200 Trainer Pro equipped with the Garmin G1275 multifunction instrument

The dashboard of the Sonaca 200 Trainer Pro has just been equipped with the Garmin G1275 which is used as a standby flight instrument. The G1275 is the same size as conventional avionics displays (3.125 inches) and can display 4 digital screens in one: attitude indicator, altimeter, speed and heading indicator. By equipping the Sonaca 200 Trainer Pro with the Garmin G1275 (backup), Sonaca Aircraft has focused on the communication, synchronization and redundancy of each instrument and, therefore, the aircraft's safety.
